What is Team Compulsories?

Six skaters (or seven skaters for FS6-10 levels) perform a lively and entertaining routine in which each skater performs one required test level maneuver. Lively music with entertaining themes, great costumes and hand-held props are featured in this event. Skaters can compete on more than one team as long as those two teams are in different freestyle levels. Skaters may skate above, but not below their own freestyle test level.

* All team members must be registered for at least one learn to skate class for the Fall, Winter, and Spring sessions of classes at IceLand and attend at least 70% of their class.

*Goal is to reuse costumes from the 2017 Spring Ice Show, costumes from past TC teams, and/or Halloween costumes. There should be no costume fee.

*Skaters must indicate their highest ISI test level on the registration form and desired team practice schedule. A/D or B/C times.

How will this work?

We have set up times for 4 teams. They are listed below. Team coaches will put skaters on teams according to their level and ability to do skills in other levels. Skaters may be on two but only if the teams practices are opposite. Skater on two teams will have to pay two registration fees and competition fees for both teams. So for example, they can be on Team A and B but not on A and D. Team letters have nothing to do with levels.

They have only to do with the practice schedule.

If additional teams need to be added we will notify those effected.
