2017 TOURNAMENT RULES

General

- 1. All USA Hockey/AHAI Rules & Regulations apply.**
- 2. All players are expected to be at the arena 1 hour prior to the scheduled starting time of their game. A tournament game can start early up to 15 minutes before its scheduled time.**
- 3. Only players rostered to the team’s USA Hockey/AHAI sanctioned roster may play for that team in the tournament. NO independent, tournament or AAU teams may participate.**
- 4. In case pullover jerseys are needed, the visiting team must wear them.**

Tentative Format (Subject to change)

Each age division will consist of a total of four teams. Each team will play each other team within their division. A Championship Game between the top two finishers of each division will play each other. A Consolation Game will be played between 3rd and 4th place prior to the Championship Game. Teams may play a game on the outdoor rink at IceLand. No games before 530 pm on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.

Games

Warm-Ups: 3 minutes
Periods: 11 minutes
Minors: 1:30 minutes
Majors: 4 minutes
Misconducts: 8 minutes

Mercy Rule: The clock shall go to running-time if the score differential is +5 in the third period, and continue running for the remaining time left in the game regardless of a reduction in score differential.

Timeouts: Each team is allowed one 30 second timeout.

Awards

Champions and Runner-Ups will receive a team and individual awards. All players will also receive a participation souvenir.

Standings

Each team receives two points for a victory and one point for a tie. In case of a tie in the standings, the following is the tie-breaking system:

- 1) Most Wins**
- 2) Head-To-Head between tied teams.**
- 3) Fewest Goals allowed in all games.**
- 4) Fewest penalty minutes in tournament.**
- 5) First Goal Scored in game between tied teams.**
- 6) Coin toss.**

Overtime (Championship game only)

If a Championship game ends regulation with the score tied, then teams shall play a 5 minute running clock sudden death overtime period. No player can play more than 2 consecutive minutes until all players have had a full shift on the ice. No time outs in overtime.

If still tied after sudden death, then a shootout shall decide the game. Prior to all championship games, teams will submit a shootout order of all players to the score keeper. If a player is in the penalty box at the end of sudden death, that player’s name is put at the end of the list. Shootouts will be a 3-player format. Teams will alternate shots; visitors/home, best of 3 shots wins. If tied after the first shootout, then a second will be done in the same manner.

If tied after the second shootout, then a third sudden death shootout occurs, home/visitor. First unanswered goal scored, wins.
