

All Star Hockey Camp Details, Policies and Procedures

Before & After Care Drop Off/Pick Up (7-9am and 4-6pm): One guardian (with a face covering on) will enter the facility to sign in/sign out their camper for the day. Guardians can drop off/pick up their kid(s) at our party room (inside the rink) which will be used for before and after care purposes.

Regular Camp Drop Off/Pick Up (9-4pm): Due to CoVid safety protocols, guardians will not be allowed into the indoor rink for regular camp drop off/pick up times. Instead, guardians (with a face covering on) will escort their camper(s) through our outdoor rink gate with their hockey equipment to sign their child in with a camp counselor. Campers will be assigned locker rooms for their hockey bag storage after everyone arrives for the day. At the end of the regular camp day, guardians are to enter through the outside rink gate where they can sign out their camper for the day.

Morning Screening: Upon daily arrival, campers will get screened by being asked a series of questions to make sure they are feeling healthy.

Lunch: Campers should bring their own lunches. The rink concession stand will not be available this summer. Camp lunches will not be put in the refrigerator. Instead, the campers have two options: 1) they can have a paper bag lunch filled with non-refrigerated items, 2) for those with lunches which need to stay cold, they should bring their own lunchbox, which includes a cold Igloo ice pack to keep their lunches cold. The camper's lunch will stay by each camper's designated area in their locker room until lunch time. Please label your child's lunch bag by putting their first and last name on it. We will be utilizing our outdoor rink (with roof) for eating lunch. Players will be spaced out. There is to be no sharing of food or utensils at camp.

Hockey Equipment: Players will be assigned to locker rooms and have their own designated area for them to leave their equipment and get changed for the ice. The players will keep this same area for the entire week of camp. Players will not be able to leave their equipment in the locker rooms overnight as our staff will be disinfecting each locker room at the end of every day. Player benches will be sanitized after each use.

Storage Baskets: Campers will be given their own personal storage basket each day where they can keep their water bottle, extra face coverings etc... These baskets will be collected at the end of each day and sanitized.

Common Room/Party Room: Will be disinfected after each use.

Face Covering: Face coverings are required while attending camp, including while on the ice. Players should bring 3 face coverings at a minimum with them per day. Two will be used and likely sweaty after the two on-ice sessions, so the kids will need a third dry mask to use while not on the ice.

Water Bottle: Campers should bring their own water bottle(s) to camp that has both their first and last name written on it.

Transportation: Any transportation that the camp uses, vans or buses, will be disinfected after each use.

Sunscreen: Please have your child apply sunscreen before arriving at camp.

Swim Day: The plan right now is for swim day to take place on Friday's. That is subject to change depending on the pool availability. The pool requires that swimmers wear swimsuits and not cut off shorts.

Hand Sanitizer: We will have hand sanitizer readily available for the campers to use. Campers will also have sinks to wash their hands with soap.

Confirmed CoVid Case: In the event that we are notified that a camper has tested positive for CoVid, the camp may shut down immediately for two weeks as a safety precaution. Refunds will be given and parents need to be prepared and have alternative/ back up plans for their children in the event that this happens.

Please note: These policies and procedures may change at any time as they are fluid, based on changes and recommendations from the State of Illinois, IDPH and the Niles Park District.
