<u>\*ONE!</u> Skaters will need to be enrolled in the Fall Session of Learn to Skate Group Classes. Skaters must meet the prerequisite listed for each class for which they plan to enroll.

## Skaters may only register for 1 group number in the Holiday Show.

<u>\*TWO!</u> Skaters must register for the Holiday Ice Show. Registration begins August 25, 2025 and runs through October 4, 2025. Skaters must meet the prerequisite listed for each group number in which they plan to enroll. With your registration you will receive: rehearsal time, professional choreography, a costume for your group number, and one professionally recorded DVD of the show. You may need to provide small costume accessories such as tights, gloves, boot covers, black pants, black shorts, turtleneck shirts, or nude leotards.

<u>\*THREE!</u> Attend your scheduled group rehearsals, the dress rehearsal, and 2 show performances. Rehearsal is mandatory. Skaters who miss more than 1 rehearsal may be ineligible to perform.

\*A limited number of registration for solo's, duets, trios, and small groups will be accepted. Do not wait to register.\*

1. Tots through Passed FS 2—Eligible to perform a solo or duet.

2. Passed ISI FS 3 though passed ISI Freestyle 5/Pre Juv. FS Test-Eligible to perform duet, trio, or small group.

3. Passed ISI Freestyle 6 with a consistent Axel and at least one consistent double jump/USFS Juvenile with a consistent Axel—Eligible to perform a solo, duet, trio, or small group.

\*All skaters may choose choice 1, 2, or 3, depending on their level at the time of registration.

\*All test requirements must completed on or before 10/4/25.

\*Skaters are responsible for their own choreography with their private coaches.

\*Skaters must provide an appropriate costume for the performances. This cannot be the same as any group costumes in the show.

\*Some music choices will be off limits for the above listed as they will be used for the group numbers.

\*Music for above must be approved by the skating director. No duplicated songs will be allowed. Have a few choices ready. Before you purchase costumes or plan choreography please get your music choice approved by the skating director.

\*Plan all programs with side scenery in mind from the front ice door running diagonally. There will be additional items placed on the ice along the boards.

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## How to measure your skater for their ice

## show costume.

Please follow these simple steps when you're ready to take body measurements.

- Have your skater wear undergarments or a lightweight leotard with a • bra that gives the bust line their typical shape for most accurate measurements.
- Have your skater stand straight with their weight evenly distributed.

The measurement tape should be snug but not too tight on circumference measurements and stretched tight for vertical measurements.

## Getting the Measurements:

- 1. Bust/Chest Measure over the fullest part of your chest with your arms relaxed at your sides.
- 2. Waist Measure around where your waist naturally indents. Keep ۰ your finger between the tape and your belly.
- **3.** Hips Measure around the fullest part of the hips and buttocks while ٠ standing with your heels together.
- **4. Girth** Measure from the midpoint on the shoulder towards the ٠ front, through the crotch and back around to meet the midpoint of the shoulder.
- 5. Inseam Measure from the crotch to the bottom. The inseam length ۰ is the number of inches, to the nearest half-inch.

#### **ICE-SKATING PROGRAM WAIVER & RELEASE**

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

The Niles Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Niles park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or adequately skilled for ice-skating activities. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

#### WARNING OF RISK

Ice-skating is intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of the participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to head injury, neck or back injury, wrist and ankle fractures, and other orthopedic injuries to limbs and joints. All hazards and dangers cannot be foreseen. The very nature of ice-skating is risky, including but not limited to slip and falls, colliding with other players of varying degrees of skill (including being struck from behind), tripping on irregular ice surfaces, cuts from skate blades, inadequate or defective equipment, ill-fitting skates, failure in supervision or instruction, horseplay, carelessness, poor technique, poor conditioning, rule violations, striking a stationary object, premises defects outside the rink, and all other risks inherent to the sport of ice-skating. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Niles Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

#### WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up and participating in the above identified programs/activities, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with said programs/activities (including transportation services/vehicle operation, when provided). I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in these programs/activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of participating in all these programs/activities against the Niles Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees (here-in after collectively referred as "District").
