BODY CONTACT & SHOOTING Clinic

This clinic will cover age specific progression of body contact skills. This will include safe ways to play along the boards, using leverage to play the puck, and "heads up

hockey". Body checking, angling and more experienced shooting techniques will be taught to the Bantam level and above players. The U8 mite thru PeeWee level players will work on the proper shooting technique for wrist and backhand shots, stick handling, puck protection, moves and fakes and angling. Both neck and mouth guards are required for this class.
