Rangers teams will participate in the Northwest Spring Hockey League and will join this year's newly formed "Park District" division, which <u>requires</u> all players and coaches to wear face coverings at the games. Rangers teams and their guest(s) will need to adhere to each rink's individual safety guidelines. Some travel to other rinks is required. Teams will play an 8 game season, 4 home and 4 away, in addition to an end-of-season tournament. All teams will receive 8 practices during the spring season and the players <u>must attend</u> the evaluations during the week of March 15. NWSHL does not allow "AAA", CSDHL, or NIHL Elite players to participate in the spring league. Any questions should be directed to Alex Alessi, Niles Hockey Director at 847-297-8010.

**Pre-requisite and Registration:** All players must be registered with USA HOCKEY and supply confirmation at the time of registration. Players not currently registered must register online with USA HOCKEY (www.usahockey.com) after April 1<sup>st</sup> for the 2021-22 season. Returning Rangers players can register for the Spring season online by emailing our front desk staff this completed packet of forms to our email at <u>rangershockey@niles-parks.org</u> New Rangers players will need to sign up in person at the IceLand front desk, as we will need to see a copy of the players birth certificate, go over available jersey numbers and ordering information, and get an updated copy of the players USA Hockey registration. Players who have not played on a team in the past will need the approval of the Hockey Director before enrolling with the Rangers.

**Requirements:** Complete equipment is required. Face coverings are required for all players and coaches. Mouth guards are recommended for Mites & Squirts and are mandatory for PeeWee-Midget. Neck guards are mandatory for all levels. The plan is currently to have checking at the bantam and midget levels. New Bantams & Midget level players who previously haven't taken a checking clinic, must attend a body contact clinic before playing in any full-check games. A checking clinic at Niles will be announced at a later date. Players must provide a white and blue Rangers jersey from the fall season to utilize during the Spring. Jerseys and socks are <u>NOT</u> included in the fees. New Rangers will have to purchase their jerseys and socks for the spring season and can get that purchasing information through the staff at the IceLand front desk.

It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

#### WARNING OF RISK

Hockey is a sport intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to head/brain injury, cervical spine injury (including paralysis) and death. All hazards and dangers cannot be foreseen. The very nature of the game of hockey is hazardous and risky, including but not limited to being tripped, body-checked, cross-checked with the stick, hit with a slash, a high stick, or a thrown stick, going head first into the boards, getting pushed or checked from behind, being cut by a skate blade, colliding with goal posts, being hit by a stick, puck, or other player's protective equipment, elbowed in the head or face, collisions with other players and stationary objects, poor officiating, injuries caused by failure to wear adequate protective equipment, inadequate playing conditions, defective equipment, imperfections in the ice, failure in supervision or instruction, unsportsmanlike conduct, and all other circumstances inherent to sport of hockey. In this regard, it is impossible for the Niles Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

#### WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

## **Guidelines**

The following guidelines shall apply to all Niles Park District activities while the State of Illinois remains in Phase 4 of Governor Pritzker's Restore Illinois program. The guidelines may be amended or updated from time to time by email notification based upon directives from State or local government or public health officials, guidance from other organizations or other events. New guidelines will be provided, and will be binding on all participants, upon the entry into Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois program. All participants must agree to comply with these or any other guidelines issued by the Niles Park District.

- Any participant who is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, including but not limited to fever, aches or respiratory issues, are prohibited from participating in any Niles Park District activities.
- Any participant who has been exposed to anyone having the COVID-19 virus or displaying symptoms of the COVID-19 virus, may not participate in any Niles Park District activities until they have been quarantined for at least fourteen (14) days without exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Any participant who learns they have contracted the COVID-19 virus after participating in any Niles Park District activity and who may have exposed other participants must notify the Niles Park District immediately.
- All Niles Park District activities will be limited to 50 or fewer participants.
- Players may share equipment and it will be sanitized after each session. All players must bring their own equipment.
- Masks and other face coverings are encouraged when appropriate.
- Practice activities shall be conducted in a manner reasonably designed to maintain social distancing where possible.
- All participants should bring hand sanitizer to each activity. Sanitizer should be applied at the beginning, the end, and periodically during activities.
- Participants should refrain from touching their faces during activities.
- Participants must clean up after themselves at the end of the activity.
- Participants may not consume snacks during the activity.

### <u>Waiver</u>

## NILES RANGERS HOCKEY PROGRAM PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

As a parent/legal guardian of a child involved in the Niles Rangers Hockey Program, I agree to abide by and follow the rules and guidelines below.

- I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will remember that my child plays hockey for his/her enjoyment, not mine.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship through my actions, by demonstrating positive support for all players.
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with the athletes to provide a positive experience for all.
- I will demand my athlete treat all players, coaches, officials, and spectators with dignity in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my athlete or the safety of others.
- I will respect the property and equipment used at any sports facility, both home and away.
- I will adhere to the Niles IceLand CoVid safety protocols.
- I will adhere to each outside rinks individual CoVid safety protocols during away games.

I understand that by signing this document I am agreeing to support and promote this Parent/Legal Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement. Further, my failure to comply with this Agreement or my participation in any of the defined **CONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE** will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from The Niles Rangers Hockey Program.

### CONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE

*Examples of words or actions which will constitute a violation of the* **Code** *include, but are not limited to, the following:* 

- Making physical contact with any player, coach, official, league representative, arena personnel, or spectator;
- Taunting or threatening any player, coach, official, league representative, arena personnel, or spectator;
- Going into the locker/dressing room of an opposing team or obstructing their access to or exit from said room and arena;
- Going into the officials' locker/dressing room or obstructing their access to or exit from said room and arena;
- Using profane and/or vulgar language or mannerisms;
- Going onto the ice surface;
- The throwing of any object onto the ice surface, into the player area(s), or at another individual;
- Pounding or climbing on the glass;
- Defacing or damaging property belonging to any individual, team, association, or arena;
- Being involved in any activity that would warrant the summoning of law enforcement officials.
- Not adhering to the CoVid safety protocols at IceLand/or surrounds rinks during games.
